



Building Effective Youth-Adult Partnerships

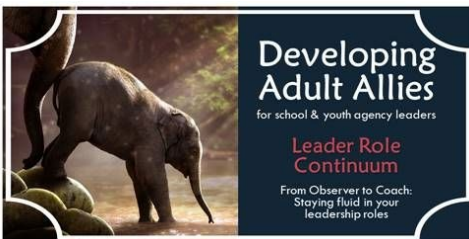
